## Rules and Regulations

Adopted November 16, 2003

The cemetery will not be plowed from December 26<sup>th</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup> only on a need be basis.

**Winter burials** will take place, weather permitting.

**Decorative fences** (metal, plastic or stones) may not be installed around graves as of April 27, 2003. The **lot owner** must maintain mowing and trimming if decorative fencing was installed prior to April 2003. If not kept in good order, fencing will be removed by the Superintendent of the Grounds.

Decorations and refuse other than natural or artificial flowers must be removed by the owner and not discarded in the trash barrel or deposited on other land adjacent to the Cemetery - **NO cardboard, wire, flowerpots, or**

**containers of any kind, etc.** - all must be taken home with the decorator.

Flowers and/or other decorations may not be placed more than **12 inches** from any side of the headstone or footstones.

The use of **glass containers** for flowers or other decorations is not permitted.

All **old decorations** left on the lot will be **removed** in the spring on or about **April 1<sup>st</sup>** and again in the fall on or about **November 1<sup>st</sup>**. Anyone wishing to keep their old decorations must remove them prior to these dates.
